

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF JUNE 22

OPERATIONS

- Patching and equipment testing in preparation of the sealcoat season continues and is making great progress. The tentative sealcoat start date is July 7th. Loose stone signs are starting to be placed around the county on sealcoat roads.
- Boom mowing continues in Hamilton Township this week.
- The first round of roadside mowing is wrapping up in Columbia Township and the second round of mowing continues in Keeler and Hartford Townships.
- A failed culvert is being replaced on CR 365 between CR 215 and 56th Street in Lawrence Township.
- Graders are working in Keeler and Lawrence Townships
- Gravel roads in Decatur and Keeler will be prepped for dust control. The dust control contractor will be in Decatur (this Friday) and Keeler (Monday 6/29).

ENGINEERING

- The CR 653 between Red Arrow Highway and 48th Avenue project in Antwerp Township continues this week with trenching and widening. The full scope of the project includes trenching, widening, drainage improvements, crushing the existing asphalt, and repaving the road. The detour for this project follows Red Arrow Highway and 30th Street.
- CR 352 from CR 681 to 60th Street in Keeler Township continues this week with lifting a section of the road and drainage improvements.
- CR 687 between CR 372 and CR 378 in Bangor and Hartford Township bids were opened and a pre-construction meeting is to be scheduled to establish the project schedule.
