OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat is anticipated on local roads in Hartford Township and on local and primary roads in Keeler Township this week. Daily locations are posted on our social media channels.
- The first round of roadside mowing continues on both primary and local roads in Antwerp and Pine Grove Townships and is nearing completion.
- Washouts are being repaired in Lawrence, Paw Paw, and Hartford Townships this week.
- VBCRC crews are completing storm clean-ups from recent severe weather. Several roads are closed due to water over the road, the full list can be found on our X page at x.com/VBCRC.

MILLAGE FACTS

- A home with a market value of \$200,000 (a taxable value of \$100,000) would pay approximately \$100 annually for the County-wide Road Millage.

ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township continues this week with drainage improvements. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township continues this week with crushing and shaping the existing asphalt and drainage improvements. The detour route for this road follows Blue Star Highway, 14th Avenue, and M-140.
- Preparations for wedge paving are expecting to begin on 38th Street between Burgess Road and 72nd Avenue in Decatur Township.
- Traffic counts are being completed on paved roads in Antwerp, Almena, Waverly, Pine Grove, Paw Paw, and Bloomingdale Townships this summer.
