

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

OPERATIONS

- Tree trimming on plow routes is scheduled to occur as staffing allows. This trimming ensures visibility for motorists as well as allows drivers to learn their routes for the new season.
- Graders and trucks with carbide scraper blades will be out preparing gravel roads for winter across the county as staffing allows.
- Crews are repairing shoulders and adding shoulder gravel across the county.
- Ditching and tree work continues on 30th Avenue between M-140 and 76th Street in Covert Township.

ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between 29th Street and CR 653 S in Pine Grove Township continues this week restoration. Pavement markings are scheduled for next week.
- CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township continues this week with guardrail placement, pending utilities being moved.
- The pavement marking contractor is out placing pavement markings as weather allows.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The VBCRC will be closed for the Thanksgiving holiday beginning at noon on Wednesday. All work, except that of an emergency nature, will be suspended until Monday, November 27th.
