ENGINEERING

Update

- The project on CR 380 from the Columbia Township Line to CR 665 in Bloomingdale Township began May 18th with trenching and widening which was completed last week. The contractor has moved on to drainage improvements with a crush, shape, and base pave scheduled for Mid to Late-June.
- CR 374 from Red Arrow Highway to 45th Street in Lawrence and Paw Paw Townships will receive the gravel shoulders this week.
- Burgess Road from 38th Street to 82nd Avenue in Decatur Township is expected to be graded next week with the base pave to follow.
