OPERATIONS

- Dust control will be beginning in Alma, Hartford, and Hamilton Townships this week before moving to Bangor, Bloomingdale, and Porter Townships.
- Crews are sweeping intersections in Bangor and South Haven Townships before moving to Covert Township.
- De-berming continues this week in Columbia Township and will move to Geneva and Bangor Townships next.

ENGINEERING

- CR 352 between CR 687 and 60th Street in Keeler Township continues with drainage work this week.
- Burgess Road between 38th Street and 82nd Avenue in Decatur Township and CR 380 between CR 665 and Columbia Township in Bloomingdale Township are both completed.
- CR 687 between 90th Avenue and CR 342 in Keeler Township continues this week with trenching and drainage work.
- 26th Street between CR 358 and 66th Avenue in Antwerp Township had shoulder prep completed last week and will continue this week with tree work. An overlay asphalt pave is expected after the Memorial Day holiday.

- The Van Buren County Road Commission will be closed Monday, May 29th in observance of the Memorial Day holiday. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, May 30th.
