## **ENGINEERING**

- · CR 352 between CR 687 and 60th Street in Keeler Township continues this week with paving. Shoulder work and restoration will follow the completion ofthe asphalt.
- · CR 687 between 90th Avenue and CR 342 in Keeler Township completed the paving portion of the project on Monday. Shoulder work and restoration are to follow pending contractor availability.
- · 26th Street between CR 358 and 66th Avenue in Antwerp Township completed the overlay portion of the project and continues this week with pavement markings and lines.
- · 26th Street between Red Arrow Highway and the Village of Mattawan in Antwerp Township starts this week with crushing and shaping the existing asphalt surface. Paving is scheduled to follow next week.
- Red Arrow Highway between CR 671 S and the Village of Lawrence in Lawrence and Paw Paw Townships is scheduled to start next week. The scope of the project is milling the top layer of asphalt and paving a new surface.
