MAINTENANCE

Operations Update

- Sealcoat operations continue on the Primary road network in the Eastern portion of the County. Daily updates are posted to our Facebook page: facebook.com/vbcrc. The full list of sealcoat and fog seal roads can be found at VBCRC.org/Sealcoat.
- Fog seal operations will begin this week starting in Pine Grove Township. Daily updates are posted to our Facebook page: facebook.com/vbcrc. As a reminder to residents, please remember to drive slowly when crossing wet fog seal applications.
- Ditching and crosspipe replacements continue across the county. Road closures for these can be found at VBCRC.org/RoadClosures.
- Regular width mowing is complete in Bangor and Covert Townships. The contractor will be working in South Haven, Bangor, and Geneva Townships this week.
- Extra width mowing is complete in Decatur Township. The contractor is currently working in Paw Paw Township.

ENGINEERING

Update

- Work on Red Arrow Highway from the Village of Paw Paw to CR 671 S in Paw Paw Township began Monday, August 1st. The project continues with the removal of the concrete curbs and trenching this week.
- Woodview Estates in Almena Township has been milled and moves forward with drainage improvements this week. Paving is planned for next week, weather permitting.
- The project on the CR 384 bridge over the Black River between 68th Street and M-43 begins this week with repairs and maintenance under the bridge deck. The expected completion date for the project is October 1st, weather permitting.
- Several jobs have been let for bid and will be opened on August 30th. The bid specifications for these projects can be found at vbcrc.org/BidOpportunities.
