OPERATIONS

- Patching continues countywide on both Primary and Local roads.
- Gravel roads are being graded across the county.
- Boom mowing continues in Pine Grove and Decatur Townships.
- Crews are sweeping intersections in Keeler and Pine Grove Townships before moving to Hamilton and Almena Townships.
- De-berming continues this week in Antwerp Township. De-berming is the process of removing sod, soil, and material that builds up along the shoulder of the roadway. De-berming assists in prolonging the life of a road by allowing water to drain from the road surface. It also helps various surface maintenance applications such as an asphalt overlay or sealcoat adhere to the road.
