MAINTENANCE

Operations Update

- VBCRC is taking full advantage of the nice weather this week and we have three tree crews out working in Bangor, Decatur, and Waverly Townships.
- Roadside mowing on the Primary System is almost complete – only Waverly, Lawrence, and Hartford remain.
- Crews are continuing to work on shoulders and trimming in preparation for plowing season.
- The stump grinding crew is working on logged requests for removals across the county.
- Graders are working in Almena, Geneva, and Lawrence.



ENGINEERING

Update

- Tree trimming and removal in Bloomingdale Township on CR 380 from the Columbia Township Line to CR 665 will begin in December, as weather and contractor schedule allows.
- CR 681 from M-51 to CR 352 in Hamilton Township will have trees trimmed and removed beginning in December, pending contractor availability and weather.
- The engineering department is working on creating estimates for projects as requested by Townships in the 2022 Road Planning Form.

MISCELLANEOUS

Update

- We have not yet received 2022 Road Planning Forms from Almena, Bangor, Bloomingdale, Geneva, Lawrence, Pine Grove, Porter, and Waverly Townships.
