

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 14

OPERATIONS

- The second round of roadside mowing is complete! The third round has started in Lawrence and Hartford Townships. Mower Operators will be clearing downed trees and debris from the ROW during the third round of mowing to prepare for snow plowing season and to make next year's mowing easier.
- Graders are treating gravel roads in Keeler, Lawrence, and Bloomingdale Townships. Contract gravel continues in Paw Paw Township.
- Crews are patching and trimming trees on their plow routes.
- Tree crews are trimming and removing trees to prep ditching and drainage improvement sites.
- VBCRC will begin dispatching 2 drainage crews each day to tackle the log of pipe replacements and ditches to be cleared. This week the crews will tackle ditching on 63rd Street in Geneva Township, ditching on 67th Street south of Territorial Road in Keeler Township, and 2 separate pipes on 62nd Street in Bangor Township.

ENGINEERING

- Pavement markings are being laid as contractor availability allows.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The VBCRC reminds residents to keep all signs, including temporary election signs, out of the ROW to ensure drivers have proper sight distance at intersections and VBCRC mowers can address roadsides. Read the news release at VBCRC.org/NewsReleases
