OPERATIONS

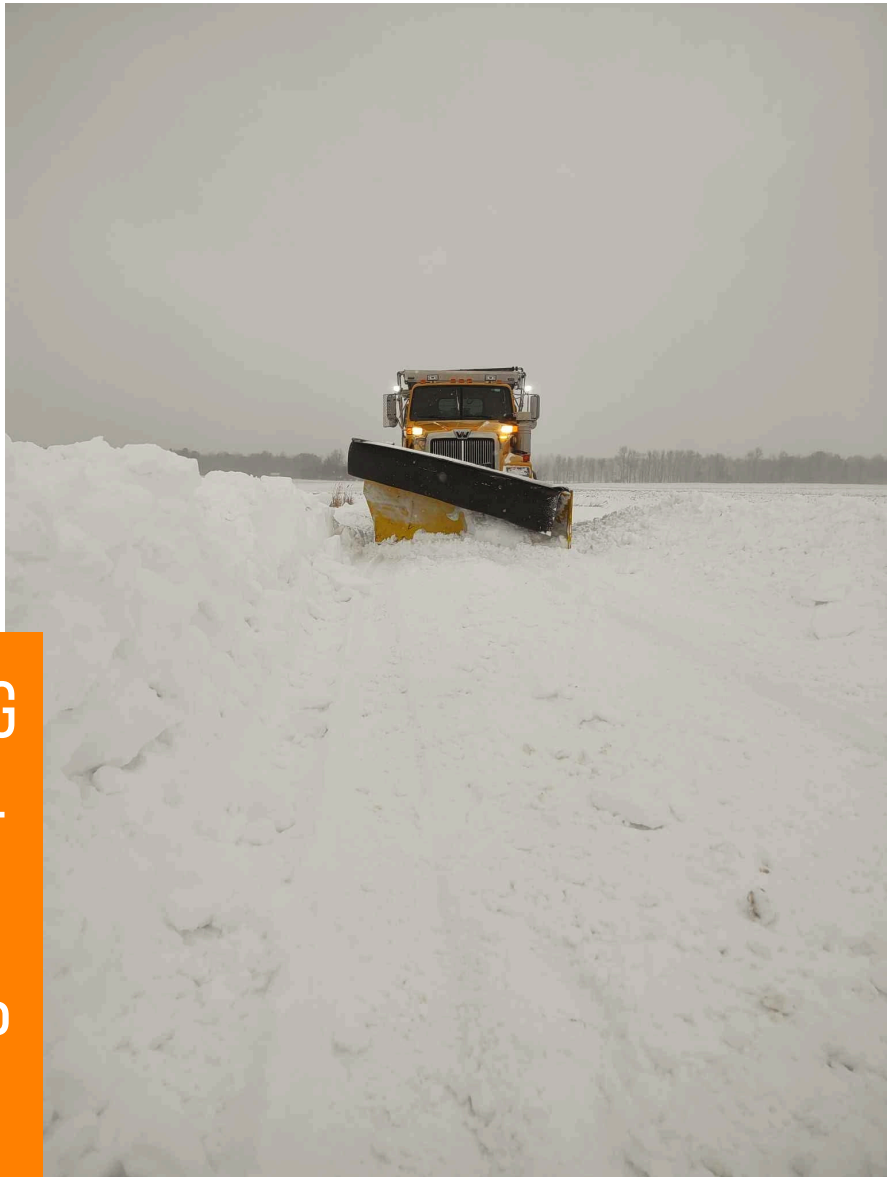
